**LITTLE CONGWONG BEACH**

I write on behalf of members of Free Beach Action Group, who ask that you declare an additional nudist beach in Sydney south of the Harbour Bridge.

The Free Beach Action Group tells me that there is only one nudist beach in Sydney south of the Harbour Bridge, which is very small and gets overcrowded in summer. They recommend listing Little Congwong Beach in La Perouse as a nudist beach in the *Local Government Act 1993*.

According to the Free Beach Action Group, Little Congwong Beach is an ideal location for a nudist beach because it is not in public view, requires a considerable walk to reach, and is within a National Park with another larger and more accessible beach at Congwong Beach. They say that Little Congwong Beach has been used for nude bathing for over 40 years.

***Could you please consider declaring Little Congwong Beach as a clothing optional beach, and inform me what action you have taken?***
